
Visit your local library or library bus, take out a book and write a review.


The book 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone' is now 20 years old. Create a new cover and blurb.

## Spring Term Homework

In addition to this homework, you will be expected to continue with daily reading, times tables practice, '**Maths Factor**', spellings and handwriting. Please take care with your handwriting. I do not expect to see rushed or messy work. If it's not neat enough, you will be made to do it again. *Remember, it is **your** job to take completed handwriting sheets out of your reading wallet or book bag and place them in the correct tray.*

Your red homework folder is for project work and should be kept at home until you have completed a project. It should then be used to transport that work to school to keep it looking smart. It's a shame when homework which has taken so much time and effort, arrives looking crumpled having been stuffed into the bottom of a book bag. The homework is to be placed in the homework tray below the laptop.

**Project work—minimum 6 pieces a term      Reading—minimum 3 x per week\*      Spellings —daily practice, tested Wednesday**

**Times tables—daily practice, tested Friday      Handwriting—weekly, handed out on Wednesday and back in by Tuesday**

**Maths Factor—as often as possible** (I check accounts regularly to monitor progress)

*\*This needs to be daily if you are aiming to be a Gold Star reader. Your reading record must be signed by an adult each day.*
